## WELCOME TO THE ABC Challenge:

We would like to thank you for being a part of the Awesome Branch Country Challenge. We hope you are ready for a fun and muddy adventure!

## **REGISTRATION:**

You should have received an email confirmation when you registered. We will have a master list at the Registration building to verify all pre-registered participants should you not be able to locate it

Here are a few things regarding registration:

- Entrance to the event is off either Sprague Street or Garfield Ave. (The Jefferson Street Fairground entrance will be closed due to course set up) Parking will be North of the Dearth Center.
- Come to the Registration Building (the red Schulabatis building) at the Fairgrounds to pick up your Registration gear. You will receive your race bib and wrist band that must be worn by the participant throughout the event. This bib number will allow the participant entry into the event.
- Every participant will receive a color-coordinated wrist band relative to their respective heat time. Registration personnel will put this band on the participant at registration. This is to be used for two items:
  - 1. For entry into their heat time.
  - 2. For obtaining their gear at the Swag Bag area. (Participant must be present and show his/her wrist band to receive their gear)
  - 3. THIS WRIST BAND MUST REMAIN ON THE PARTICIPANT AT ALL TIMES!
- Print and fill out completely the Waiver/Release form (for Teams and Mail in Registrations - located on our website registration page) and bring with you. This will help the flow of the registration process.
- We would like everyone to **be at the event 45 minutes prior to your event heat time**. The gates will open at 8:00am on the day of the event.
